Re: Letter 05-ED-048, from R. Schepens, USDOE, to M. Wilson, Ecology, "Schedule of Notice of Deficiency (NOD) Workshops for the Double Shell Tank (DST) System Resource and Conservation and Recovery Act Part B Application", dated June 17, 2005 65612

Ecology has reviewed your request for an additional 60 days for the DST Permit Application NOD workshops. We understand that the U.S. Department of Energy-Office of River Protection was unable to support the June 6, 2005, date for the completion of the NOD workshops because of competing permit activities.

Although Ecology could have supported the original completion date for the NOD workshops, the proposed schedule revision is acceptable. The revised schedule shows the NOD workshop completion date as August 5, 2005.
