Key cultural resources items that came up during our reconnaissance of TWRS sites; based on discussions with Natalie Cadoret, PNL Cult. Resources Specialist  
• Surveys of Phased Implementation site in 200 East found no cultural resources.  
• There are no prehistoric resources known at Pit 30 but there is one unvaluated homestead era structure in the area.  
• McGee Ranch has been judged eligible for nomination to the National Register. The most important resources are the numerous homestead era structures from several different ranches, a wooden irrigation system portions of which are in good condition, and structures where an employee lived that he

Issues/Concerns Identified: (Unresolved questions)  
Dirt partly into a hillside  
• Vermula Quarry has been only partially surveyed. Cultural resources were found there (both historic and prehistoric) including rock cairns, and more materials are likely to be found.

Required Actions:  
• N. Cadoret will provide a memo describing McGee Ranch cultural resources, from the National Register nomination package. She will not provide the entire package because it contains sensitive materials (site locations etc.)
