Re: Proposed Deletion of USDOE's Hanford 1100 Area from the National Priorities List

We received your notification that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) proposes deletion of the U. S. Department of Energy's Hanford 1100 Area from the National Priorities List (NPL). The site includes the isolated sites on the Fitzner-Eberhardt Arid Lands Ecology Reserve, as well as, the central warehousing and transportation center for the entire Hanford Site.

We concur with EPA's decision to delete the 1100 Area from the NPL, since the requirements of Superfund have been met and no further remedial action is required at this time.
