
Dear Mr. Faulk,




Please do not restart Hanford's FFTF Nuclear Reactor for plutonium production.

- ✓ Keeping FFTF on "hot standby" since 1996 has already wasted over \$100 million dollars of vital Hanford clean-up funds. Meanwhile the U.S. Dept. of Energy claims they lack the funds to clean up along the Hanford Reach of the Columbia River, where water contamination has already been documented.
- ✓ The current FFTF restart scenario includes producing Plutonium-238. We have no guarantee that U.S. Dept. of Energy will not reverse its earlier decision and have FFTF move into Tritium production or other nuclear weapons work.
- ✓ FFTF restart would require importation of dangerous Plutonium fuel into our region. A train or truck accident would be disastrous.
- ✓ FFTF reactor restart violates the Tri-Party Agreement, the Hanford Cleanup Agreement.
- ✓ Restarting the FFTF nuclear reactor would create more liquid high-level waste. This waste would be stored in Hanford's high level nuclear waste tanks, where at least 66 tanks already leak and 28 more are on a special watch list due to possible risk explosion.
- ✓ Hanford Manager, Keith Klein, calls FFTF restart "more exciting" than clean up. I don't trust the U.S. Dept. of Energy and Hanford contractors to put their full focus on clean up while there is a nuclear production mission in progress.



To Representatives of EPA, Washington Department of Ecology, DOE and Contractor Personnel,

Thank you very much for taking the time to travel to Portland with presentations concerning the 100 Area Clean Up. Following are some points that I believe are important regarding policy making on this issue.

1. The policy making at Hanford is supposed to incorporate public values. One of the most important values to the citizens of the Northwest is protecting the Columbia River, now and for future generations.

2. This 100 Area is the point of origin of much of the toxic legacy of the Cold War Mess. It has great symbolic, historic, cultural and ecologic significance. It is unconscionable and unacceptable to consider thinking as is indicated by the Inspector General that cleanup along the Columbia costs too much to make it worthwhile.

a. When the reactors were in operation the managers acted irresponsibly and without vision. Now we must not repeat the same mistakes. That would be an insult to the Earth and the People of the Northwest. It is important to clean up this area as well as we can with current technology (and research solutions for contamination that is problematic)

not only to protect the River and species, but also because it is the morally correct thing to do. That is worthwhile.

b. The cost. Everyone knows we have spent over \$5 Trillion during the Cold War. Money was no object in reaching our goal to win and defend!! We live in a rich country. Reports say the economy is booming. Military budget is increasing. Golden parachutes fill the corporate skies. We entertain ideas of a very expensive Star Wars Defense. But when it comes to clean up programs our budgets shrink. We cannot meet regulations.

We struggle to characterize, monitor and contain contamination and have little resources or political will for aggressive clean up. This is an unacceptable situation. Not only are we allowing poisons to seep into the future, but we are also saying that protecting our waters, homeland and people is a low priority. It costs too much. This kind of policy only serves to anger citizens and erode confidence and participation in politics and government.

3. Hanford Clean Up is a formidable and complicated task. We are thankful for the progress that has taken place and applaud the efforts of the many people who undertake difficult projects and pioneering technologies. The Hanford Site has so many diverse problems that it could become the world class leader in clean up development and implementation (and provide meaningful, honorable work for generations...) Clean up is sorely needed, very worthwhile and worth our investment.

5. The consequences of shoddy clean up will impact us in ways that we know and in ways that are not totally predictable. For our sakes and for the future the USDOE should follow the requirements of Washington State's Cleanup Standards under MTCA along the Columbia River.

Thank you all for your efforts, public dialogs and consideration of this input.

# "This earth is sacred"

*The following letter, written in 1855, was sent to President Franklin Pierce by Chief Sealth of the Duwamish Tribe of the State of Washington. It concerns the proposed purchase of the tribe's land. Seattle, a corruption of the chief's name, is built in the heart of Duwamish land. The letter is printed courtesy of Dale Jones of the Seattle office of Friends of the Earth.*

The Great Chief in Washington sends word that he wishes to buy our land. The Great Chief also sends us words of friendship and good will. This is kind of him, since we know he has little need of our friendship in return. But we will consider your offer, for we know if we do not so, the white man may come with guns and take our land. What Chief Sealth says, the Great Chief in Washington can count on as truly as our white brothers can count on the return of the seasons. My words are like the stars — they do not set.

How can you buy or sell the sky — the warmth of the land? The idea is strange to us. Yet we do not own the freshness of the air or the sparkle of the water. How can you buy them from us? We will decide in our time. Every part of this earth is sacred to my people. Every shining pine needle, every sandy shore, every mist in the dark woods, every clearing and humming insect is holy in the memory and experience of my people.

We know that the white man does not understand our ways. One portion of the land is the same to him as the next, for he is a stranger who comes in the night and takes from the land whatever he needs. The earth is not his brother, but his enemy, and when he has conquered it, he moves on. He leaves his fathers' graves, and his children's birthright is forgotten. The sight of your cities pains the eyes of the redman. But perhaps it is because the redman is a savage and does not understand . . .

There is no quiet place in the white man's cities. No place to hear the leaves of spring or the rustle of insect's wings. But perhaps because I am a savage and do not understand — the clatter only seems to insult the ears. And what is there to life if a man cannot hear the lovely cry of a whippoorwill or the arguments of the frogs around a pond at night? The Indian prefers the soft sound of the wind darting over the face of the pond, and the smell of the wind itself deansed by a mid-day rain, or scented with a pinon pine. The air is precious to the redman. For all things share the same breath — the beasts, the trees, the man. The white man does not seem to notice the air he breathes. Like a man dying for many days, he is numb to the stench.

If I decide to accept, I will make one condition. The white man must treat the beasts of this land as his brothers. I am a savage and I do not understand any other way. I have seen a thousand rotting buffaloes on the prairies left by the white man who shot them from a

passing train. I am a savage and I do not understand how the smoking iron horse can be more important than the buffalo that we kill only to stay alive. What is man without the beasts? If all the beasts were gone, men would die from great loneliness of spirit, for whatever happens to the beast also happens to man. All things are connected. Whatever befalls the earth befalls the sons of the earth.

Our children have seen their fathers humbled in defeat. Our warriors have felt shame. And after defeat, they turn their days in idleness and contaminate their bodies with sweet food and strong drink. It matters little where we pass the rest of our days — they are not many. A few more hours, a few more winters, and none of the children of the great tribes that once lived on this earth, or that roamed in small bands in the woods, will be left to mourn the graves of a people once as powerful and hopeful as yours.

One thing we know which the white man may one day discover. Our God is the same God. You may think now that you own him as you wish to own our land. But you cannot. He is the Body of man. And his compassion is equal for the redman and the white. This earth is precious to him. And to harm the earth is to heap contempt on its creator. The whites, too, shall pass — perhaps sooner than other tribes. Continue to contaminate your bed, and you will one night suffocate in your own waste. When the buffalo are all slaughtered, the wild horses all tamed, the secret corners of the forest heavy with the scent of many men, and the view of the ripe hills blotted by talking wires, where is the thicket? Gone. Where is the eagle? Gone. And what is it to say goodbye to the swift and the hunt, the end of living and the beginning of survival.

We might understand if we knew what it was that the white man dreams, what hopes he describes to his children on long winter nights, what visions he burns into their minds, so they will wish for tomorrow. But we are savages. The white man's dreams are hidden from us. And because they are hidden, we will go our own way. If we agree, it will be to secure your reservation you have promised. There perhaps we may live out our brief days as we wish. When the last redman has vanished from the earth, and the memory is only

the shadow of a cloud moving across the prairie, these shores and forest will still hold the spirits of my people, for they love this earth as the newborn loves its mother's heartbeat. If we sell you our land, love it as we've loved it. Care for it, as we've cared for it. Hold in your mind the memory of the land, as it is when you take it. And with all your strength, with all your might, and with all your heart — preserve it for your children, and love it as God loves us all. One thing we know — our God is the same. This earth is precious to him. Even the white man cannot be exempt from the common destiny.
