



WSCF PMM Minutes for September, held on September 26, 2012 at 8am in the Mt Baker Room, WDOE

- ECO Discussion
 1. Discuss any compliance questions/issues-
 - M. Mills indicated that there are preliminary decisions being talked about on the Hanford Site with regards to shutting down ETF over the next few years. This results in WSCF looking at Treatment-By-Generator (TBG) options for some of the waste streams generated in the lab.
 - D. Singleton asked L. Fearon to look into how Ecology's Manchester Lab is conducting SAA activities and to provide any parallels/insight for WSCF guidance on SAAs.
