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This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

This site is a sanitary drainfield associated with the 2607-E3 septic system. The system has been deactivated.

Basis for reclassification:

When the 2607-E3 Septic System was documented within WIDS, it was added as two separate sites: 2607-E3 (septic tank) and TFS of 218-E-4 a.k.a. Tile Field South of 218-E-4 (sanitary drainfield). In most other cases within the WIDS, septic systems are documented as a single WIDS site which includes the septic tank, the drain field, and other associated piping.

The 2607-E3 Septic Tank and the TFS of 218-E-4 have been consolidated under WIDS Site Code 2607-E3. The WIDS write up for 2607-E3 has been updated to include information that had been documented in TSF of 218-E-4. In the future, the two septic system components will be tracked under the single WIDS Site Code 2607-E3.
