



**UNIT MANAGERS' MEETING: B PLANT DISPUTE RESOLUTION
MEETING SUMMARY/SUMMARY OF ACTIONS TIMES AND AGREEMENTS**

June 25, 1993

Opening Remarks: (L. E. Borneman, WHC) The meeting was opened and introductions were made.

The background of the Dispute was provided by Ms. Borneman. The background of the dispute can be found in Handout 1, " Statement of Dispute for M-17-04D."

1. Keeping tanks and ancillary equipment in the 211-B Area of B Plant after removal of inventory

Ecology (G. Davis and M. Selby, Ecology) stated their concerns with leaving tanks and ancillary equipment in place in the 211-B Area of B Plant after removal of the HEDTA, EDTA, and ANN inventory that is being stored there. Ecology would like to see physical barriers installed in the lines.

Discussion ensued about the removal of the HEDTA, EDTA, and ANN product that is being stored in the tanks in question in the 211-B Area of B Plant. WHC indicated that the inventory would be removed by November 1993 as outlined in Handout #1 and that the tanks would be cleaned by that date. Ecology indicated that triple rinsing the tanks would be sufficient to remove the heel.

RL committed to notify Ecology if the tanks in the 211-B Area that do not have secondary containment are re-used in place or if the tanks are removed.

RL committed to informally notify (i.e., phone call) Ecology when the lines leading to and from the tanks in the 211-B Area would be blanked-off.

Action 6/25/93-01: RL will provide a letter to Ecology that states a date for when lines leading to and from the tanks will be blanked.

Action: Romine (RL) and Halgren (WHC)

Due Date: 7/30/93

2. Disposition of the ANN, EDTA, and HEDTA Product.

WHC indicated that approximately 3300 gallons of ANN have been shipped to Plutonium Finishing Plant (PFP). Ecology was concerned that the tanks being used at PFP to store the ANN product have secondary containment. WHC and RL assured Ecology that the PFP tanks had secondary containment.

WHC indicated that the balance of the ANN, HEDTA, and EDTA are being placed for sale on the open market (i.e, disposition off the Hanford Site).

3. Consent Order

Ecology (M. Selby) stated that she would recommend approval of the Consent Order change, which is included in Handout #1, to her management after her receipt of the letter committing RL to a date for physically isolating the tanks in question in the 211 B Area of B Plant.

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
