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

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



- I. Approval of the August 30, 2001 200LWPF Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status
 - A. 242-A Evaporator
Evaporator is in Shutdown mode
 - B. Liquid Effluent Retention Facility (LERF)
Waste Inventory (9/16/01)
 - Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 8.1 ft or 1.8 Mgal
 - Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 15.9 ft or 4.6 Mgal
 - Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 17.7 ft or 5.2 Mgal
 - C. Wastes received in LERF during August:
 - Basin 42 received two 500 gallon tankers of wastewater from HEHF
 - Basin 42 received two tanker shipments from PNNL 323 Building, Tank 4
 - Basin 42 received one tanker shipment of leachate from mixed waste burial trench
 - Basin 43 received UP-1 groundwater by transfer line at about 50 gpm during August.
 - D. 200 Area Effluent Treatment Facility (ETF)
ETF is operating, processing UP-1 groundwater
 - E. 200 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility (TEDF)
August monthly flows:
 - Total discharge: 2.3 Mgal
 - Minimum daily flow: 10 gpm (8/3/01)
 - Maximum daily flow: 125 gpm (8/26/01)
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Delisting Petition
 1. Jamie Granger (FH) reported that the Delisting Petition was delivered to Ecology, EPA and RL. Jamie had asked Kathy Conaway (Ecology) when comments could be expected from Ecology.

B. LERF Groundwater

1. Fred Jamison stated that the third meeting was held at Ecology where the group framed a way to conduct roundtable discussions. RL and the contractors came together and set the agenda for the next meeting. Ecology presented an approach to the meetings that clarified the intent of the proposal. The next meeting is scheduled for October 4 at HAMMER.

C. PCB Path Forward

1. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) reported that he had met with Dave Bartus (EPA) who did not believe that the current approach was consistent with previous agreements. A teleconference is scheduled later today with EPA headquarters to discuss the regulatory paths available. The facility is proposing a risk-based plus performance-based approach.

D. Status of Permit Revisions

1. Roger reported that the modification package has been submitted. Later modifications will include 242A upgrades, valve and compressor replacements, and replacement of the roof. They are currently looking at trying to schedule modifications so as not to impact evaporator campaigns.
2. The UP-1 pump and treat modifications will use a well that is across the street. A second pump and treat well will be added later.
3. The LERF facility has been taking manual readings on all liquid levels to assure accuracy of the readings. They are looking at installing new monitor probes that would improve the facility's ability to monitor liquid levels.

IV. General Discussion

- A. Kevin Leary (DOE-RL) reported that there appear to be issues at DOE Headquarters regarding evaporators in the complex. RL has received a request from Headquarters asking for information on Hanford's evaporator, but are unsure as to the exact nature of the concerns. There appears to be some DNFSB interest.
- B. Kevin also mentioned that a contractor is looking at the possibility of sharing tritium technology.

V. Status of Action Items

- A. LWPF-00-004 (561) remains open. A draft was provided to Ecology on September 7.
- B. LWPF-00-018 (709) remains open. The next workshop is scheduled for October 4.
- C. LWPF-00-024 (757) remains open. Waiting for comments. Jamie Granger will get with Dave Bartus and Kathy Conaway on the schedule.
