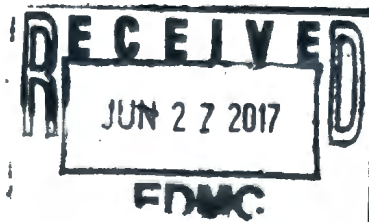
Dear Mr. Shoop:

Thank you for completing an application for renewal of State Waste Discharge Permit No. ST0045514 (ST45514), received by this office on April 10, 2017. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed and accepted your application as sufficiently complete on June 19, 2017. Although the application is sufficiently complete, Ecology may request additional information prior to permit issuance.

Ecology is currently drafting the permit. However, we will not be able to complete issuance before the permit expiration date on June 30, 2017. Therefore, we are extending the term of permit ST45514. This extension will allow Ecology additional time to review the renewal application and will allow the United States Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (USDOE-RL) sufficient time to provide the requested clarifying information.

Until the renewal permit is issued, the terms and conditions of the current ST45514 permit will remain in effect. Those terms and conditions are enforceable for up to five years following the current expiration date, or until further notice by Ecology.



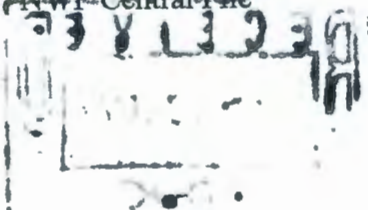
