**Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements****200 AREA EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY****1. STATUS OF SCHEDULE/DESIGN/CONSTRUCTION**

Mr. D. Flyckt (WHC) reported that the Effluent Treatment Facility (ETF) began Phase 3 testing on November 12, 1995. Process condensate from the Liquid Effluent Retention Facility (LERF) was processed in the ETF for a short period of time; and then shut down to make adjustments to the system on November 14, 1995. The ETF was restarted and it has been running at a volume of 40-80 gal/min. Next Wednesday, November 22, the volume will increase to 150 gal/min.

**2. PROGRAM STATUS**

- Discussion of 200 Area cross site pipeline

Mr. R. Julian (Ecology) handed out an equivalency approval for the transfer pipeline (Attachment 5). Mr. W. Toebe (WHC) concurred with the wording in the handout. Mr. Julian will give a copy of the handout to Dib Goswami (Ecology) to incorporate into the Record of Decision as necessary.

**EQUIVALENCY APPROVAL FOR THE TRANSFER PIPELINE**

With regards to the use of the existing single walled pipe-line to transfer liquid waste from the 200 West Area to the Effluent Treatment Facility (C-018) in the 200 East Area, WAC 173-303-640(4) provides for "An equivalent device as approved by the department.) as secondary containment.

A method of measuring the flow into the pipe and measuring the flow exiting the pipe, (a calibrated totaling device at each end of the pipe-line), along with pressure testing of the pipe-line within the time limits of WAC 173-303, (annually), and approved by Ecology will meet the requirements of the regulations.
