

3. Comment:

Aerial photo GE-2163 (7/20/1953) shows a trench filled with debris, located south of 2101M. An eariler photo GE-1624 (4/24/1953) shows smoke emitting from the same trench, sugesting it was used as a burn pit. Since the photos were taken during the construction of 2101M, it is likely this trench was used to dispose of construction waste.

The burn pit is not longer visible. The pit was active in 1953. More recent road construction and facility installations have obsured evidence of the burn pit. The photographic images were used to create a mapped shape file that places the pit location adjacent to the 2750E building. Based on the assumed ground disturbance required to construct the large 2750E building and install support utilities, the burn pit is assumed to have been exhumed during the 2750E construction activities.
