



I Approval of the October 17, 2002 200LWPF/310 TEDF Project Meeting Minutes Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)

II Operational Status (Roger Szelmeczka FH)

### **242-A EVAPORATOR**

- Campaign 2002-02 currently underway
- Campaign 2003-01 scheduled for December 11

### **LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)**

Waste Inventory (11/11/2)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 2.0 ft or 0.4 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 16.1 ft or 4.7 Mgal (Receiving groundwater at 47 gpm)
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 16.5 ft or 4.8 Mgal

Wastewaters received during October:

- Basin 42 received 7,200 gallons leachate from the Mixed Waste Burial Trench
- Basin 42 received 11,000 gallons from certification testing of 3 tankers
- Basin 44 received 4000 gallons by tanker from the Cold Vacuum Drying facility
- Basin 44 received 16,000 gallons by tanker from the 105-KW Basin

### **EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)**

- ETF on standby during Evaporator Campaign

### **200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)**

October monthly flow summary:

- Total discharge: 12 Mgal
- Average monthly flow: 271 gpm
- Minimum daily flow: 2 gpm
- Maximum daily flow: 2598 gpm (242-A cooling water resumed 10/29)

### **300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)**

- 3.67 million gallons of treated effluent discharged during the month of October
- 1 tanker and 2 drums of wastewater received
- TEDF continues in normal operations.

### **LWPF SAFETY RECORD**

1118 days since last lost time event

- III Project Specific Issues
  - A Delisting Petition Discussion
    - 1 Roger Szelmezcza reported the final comments and technical edits are being incorporated into the draft proposed rule. One item, how to address the chromium level, remains to be discussed with EPA. This activity is currently two and a half months behind schedule.
  - B LERF Groundwater Discussion
    - 1 The supplemental information submitted by RL is incomplete and Ecology has requested additional details on the leachate monitoring. RL was requested to submit the information within two weeks. Grant Baston (RL) agreed to check on the status.
  - C PCB Path Forward
    - 1 Ellen Mattlin (RL) stated that since the EPA approval letter expires the end of the calendar year, RL would need to obtain an extension of the date or a finalized RBDA. This has the potential to delay evaporator campaigns scheduled for early next year. Kathy Conaway will call EPA and have Dave Bartus contact Ms Mattlin.
  - D Status of Permit Revisions
    - 1 Roger Szelmezcza provided Ecology with an advance copy of the modification package due in January. The 242A revisions are being submitted in the new format and are expected to be sent to Ecology in late December.
  - E Status of 242A Upgrades
    - 1 The evaporator upgrades are still planned but may be impacted by the campaign schedule. Work to be done between campaigns will include pump and jumper replacements. Tank farms is funding the upgrades.
- IV General Discussions
  - A No further discussions to report.
- V Status of Actions
  - A 709 – remains open. RL submitted supplemental information. Ecology has requested additional details.
  - B 810 – remains open. A preliminary meeting was held November 13. Additional meetings to be scheduled.
  - C 823 – remains open. A meeting was held to discuss what Ecology's interests are. Ellen Mattlin will provide a revised change request form to move the report cycle to every 5 years. If necessary, Kathy Conaway will provide a letter to relieve RL from the 2003 report submittal.
- VI New Action Items
  - A No new action items to report.

  - A The next Project Managers meeting is scheduled for December 19, 2002
