





HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (HFFACO) EXTENSION OF DISPUTE AT THE INTERAGENCY MANAGEMENT INTEGRATION TEAM (IAMIT) LEVEL REGARDING THE STATEMENT OF DISPUTE FOR THE 116-N-1 RECLASSIFICATION FROM FEBRUARY 8, 2008, TO MARCH 31, 2008

Per Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Article VII, Resolution of Disputes, 30, E., RL and Ecology agree to extend the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order 116-N-1 Reclassification Dispute at the IAMIT level from February 8, 2008, to March 31, 2008. The extension is required to allow for the agencies to further evaluate CERCLA and RCRA information. The U.S. Department of Energy initiated dispute in the RL to Ecology letter, 08-AMRC-0095, January 18, 2008, Statement of Dispute for the 116-N-1 Crib and Trench and this agreement extends that dispute at the project manager level.
