### SUMMARY

7 Harry talked to HTIS and said that the three most likely dry cleaning solvents used between 1943-1958 (pre-60s by the Military) are Carbon-Tet (Carbon Tetra Chloride) most commonly used 1930s to WWII.

Others are 111 TCE, 112 TCE, Perchlorethane (PCE) - used to replace Carbon-Tet, and Stoddard solvent used a lot now and early 60s.


