This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

This unit is a rectangular burning pit trench located within (under) Burial Ground 218-W-4C. Stenner et al. report that the burning pit was exhumed during the excavation of Trench 7 in 218-W-4C. The Z Plant Burning Pit was a disposal site for combustible nonradioactive construction, office and non-hazardous laboratory waste, including unnamed chemicals. The burn pit is reported to have received 2,000 cubic meters (70,000 cubic feet) of wastes for burning, including 'less than' 1,000 cubic meters (35,000 cubic feet) of laboratory chemicals.

Because the site is entirely contained within the burial ground, and was exhumed during construction of the burial ground, it is proposed for consolidation with site 218-W-4C.

Basis for reclassification:

The site is being consolidated with Burial Ground 218-W-4C. The burn pit is entirely contained with the larger burial ground, and is reported to have been excavated during construction of the burial ground. Future remedial activities will address both site together, and the sites are mutually linked under the Regulatory tab page of WIDS.
