Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

The minutes from the January 12, 1993, and the February 10, 1993, meetings were reviewed and approved by the Unit Managers.

2. Status Closure Activities

- Discussion of Ecology's review of NOD comment response table:

Several details from the NOD's dated February 16, 1993, were discussed. Consideration was given to the proper name of the document; i.e., will Revision 1 be called a closure plan or a closure/postclosure plan. Ecology (McKinney) will investigate this issue. Authority of approval of the HWOP was also discussed. Ecology stated that they have authority to stop work if they feel that worker safety is at risk; RL/WHC maintain that this does not constitute approval authority.

3. New Business

RL/WHC discussed the need for a 30-day extension for revision of the LSFF Closure Plan. A letter requesting this will be transmitted to Ecology and the EPA soon. Upon approval, the new due date for the Closure Plan will be June 25, 1993. Ecology concurred.

4. Set Next Meeting Date

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, April 8, 1993.
