NOTICE OF INTENT TO PREPARE AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR  
THE PLUTONIUM FINISHING PLANT STABILIZATION

Dear Addressee:

The Department of Energy Richland Operations Office published a Notice of Intent to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Plutonium Finishing Plant Stabilization, at the Hanford Site, Richland, Washington. The formal public scoping process for the EIS began with publication of a Notice of Intent on October 27, 1994, and ended on December 12, 1994.

In accordance with the Department's National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) regulations (10 CFR 10221.312) we have prepared an implementation plan (Enclosure). The plan provides guidance for preparation of the EIS and a description of the public scoping process, including a summary of all comments received and their disposition. 
