This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The release was documented on a Telephone Report relating to a personnel contamination. The release location description is vague, stating only that it occurred in a valve pit (unidentified) outside 202-A. Smearable contamination of 8,000 counts per minute beta-gamma and 1,000 disintegrations per minute alpha were recorded on the worker. A lung count on the employee showed less than 0.16 nanocuries of americium-241. No ground contamination or clean up actions were recorded. The location of the source of the personnel contamination is unknown.

Basis for reclassification:

This WIDS site was created because of a 1974 personnel contamination incident. The location of the incident is not known or identified any more than "a valve pit outside of 202-A." The location is presumed to be within the fenced boundary of the PUREX facility, which is surveyed for radiation on a regular basis.
