
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

The release occurred on July 24, 1967 during removal of two pumps from A cell of the Strontium Semiworks facility. The contaminated area consisted of a fan-shaped area extending 150 yards (137 meters) wide and 300 yards (275 meters) long north of A cell at Semiworks (201-C). The release effected the road and land north of Strontium Semiworks. The contamination levels ranged from 30,000 to 80,000 counts per minute over the general area. In 1967, all personnel were surveyed and released. The roadways were blocked and flushed with water by the fire department.

**Basis for reclassification:**

The Semiworks facilities have demolished. The area has been surface stabilized with clean material. The stabilized area is now WIDS sitecode 200-E-41. The release site is not separately marked or posted. No visual evidence of the site remains. The roadways were flushed with water in 1967. It is recommended this site be reclassified to Reject Consolidated with 200-E-41.
