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

SUBMITTAL OF THE LIMITED FIELD INVESTIGATION (LFI) REPORT FOR THE 100-FR-1 OPERABLE UNIT, DRAFT A, AND THE QUALITATIVE RISK ASSESSMENT (QRA) FOR THE 100-FR-1 OPERABLE UNIT; REVISION 0

Please find attached 3 copies each of DOE/RL-93-82, Limited Field Investigation Report for the 100-FR-1 Operable Unit, Draft A, and BHI-00053, Qualitative Risk Assessment for the 100-FR-1 Operable Unit, Revision 0, for review. This transmittal completes the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office's support of Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Interim Milestone M-15-138, which requires submittal of the LFI and QRA Reports by September 30, 1994. Comments are requested within 45 days of receipt of these documents or by November 15, 1994.

The LFI Report compiles data relevant to contamination as identified in the 100-FR-1 Work Plan. With this data and the associated QRA, these reports provide a basis for making the recommendation to perform an interim remedial measure or defer to the formal remedial investigation/feasibility study process.
