Re: Concurrence with Inclusion of 1607-D-2 in Remedial Action

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) concurs with the inclusion of the 1607-D-2 Septic Tank during the remedial actions for the 100-BC-1, 100-DR-1, and 100-HR-1 Operable Units Record of Decision (ROD). The location of this waste site, adjacent to and within the area required for remediation of the identified high priority sites, meets the intent of the ROD. However, Ecology recognizes a certain amount of controversy surrounding the contaminants of concern identified for the 1607-D-2 Septic Tank, and requests the opportunity to discuss this topic with the U.S. Department of Energy for the purpose of reaching documented agreement.
