The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) hereby provides notification of the completion of the subject milestone. Field activities for this milestone were completed on December 30, 2007.

RL appreciates the extensive efforts of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency staff in working with us to accomplish this milestone and performing cleanup activities in the River Corridor. Significant cleanup progress has been made, including the disposition of spent nuclear fuel discovered in several burial grounds, disposition of many anomalous waste items which required special handling and additional characterization, as well as the treatment of waste contained in below-ground tanks in order to meet the waste acceptance criteria of the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility.
