REPACKAGE PRIORITY FOR CONTAINER WH-76-630

The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (RL) and CH2M HILL Plateau Remediation Company (CHPRC) its contractor, have assessed the surface rust and integrity of Container WH-76-630 and determined that the container does not have any indication of leakage. Based on discussions with you and your staff, RL and CHPRC have prioritized the container to be repackaged within the next six months. Once repackaged, the volume of this container will count towards the M-91-47 milestone series.
