





## LLBG PROJECT MEETING MINUTES

Project Managers Meeting

- I. Approval of the August 30, 2001 LLBG Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status
  - No Non-ATG Waste Accepted at the LLBG in August
  - No Waste Shipped from ATG to Trench 34 in August
  - No Reactor Compartments Received in August
- III. Project Specific Issues
  - A. Schedule for WAP workshops and draft submittal
    1. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) reported that she had a conversation with Jeanne Wallace (Ecology) and they agreed that FH will not be moving forward with a combined WAP but will be doing project-specific WAPs. The T Plant and LLBG time frames could be shortened due to sections common to both facilities. Jeannette indicated that work is continuing on the WAP schedule. Jeanne agreed to get with Greta Davis (Ecology) to see what her schedules needs are.
  - B. Status of workshop negotiations on Part A application
    1. Dan Saueressig reported that there continue to be some disagreements at workshops on how to approach the boundary issue at LLBG. Dan thought it might be time to get counsel involved and determine a legal position.
    2. The next workshop is scheduled for the week of October 15.
    3. Fred Jamison (Ecology) said he hoped to clear the water's soon on the NEPA/SEPA concerns and get movement on the issues.
- IV. General Discussion
  - A. Fred Jamison was interested in learning if anyone has had any previous experience with moving from interim status (Part A) to final status (Part B) while dealing with similar issues (changing TSD boundaries). He is looking for parallel examples to help with the current issues.
  - B. Jamie Granger brought up the issue of updating action tracking items only with discussions from the project meetings or provide a more real-time tracking. It was decided that updates will be included to the action tracking database as they occur and will be reviewed at the PMM.

**V. Status of Action Items**

- A. SWSD-99-003 (565) remains open. A comment was added on 9/5 to show progress on the workshop schedule. Next workshop scheduled for the week of 10/15.
- B. SWSD-00-005 (568) remains open. Ecology's response is expected 10/5.
- C. SWSD-00-007 (570) remains open. Waiting to finalize the boundary issues.
