CLOSURE CERTIFICATION FOR THE 218-E-8 BORROW PIT DEMOLITION SITE (T-2-1),
200 WEST AREA ASH PIT DEMOLITION SITE (T-2-2), AND HANFORD PATROL ACADEMY
DEMOLITION SITES (T-11-1)

Enclosed are the completed Closure Certifications for the 218-E-8 Borrow Pit Demolition Site, 200 West Area Ash Pit Demolition Site, and Hanford Patrol Academy Demolition Sites (HPADS). These certifications have been signed by an independent, registered professional engineer, by the Westinghouse Hanford Company (WHC) as facility co-operator, and by the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) as facility owner-operator. These signatures certify that the closure of these three units has been completed in accordance with the specifications of each closure plan. These certifications are required by Washington Administrative Code 173-303-610(6), and were prepared in accordance with "Chapter 7" of the 218-E-8 Borrow Pit Demolition Site, 200 West Area Ash Pit Demolition Site, and HPADS Closure Plans and Conditions V.5.B.e, V.6.B.e, and V.9.B.e of the Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit.

All three demolition sites were treatment units used for the detonation of discarded explosive chemical products that were determined to be in excess or beyond their shelf life. Operations at the three demolition sites occurred as follows: a single detonation occurred at the 218-E-8 Borrow Pit Demolition Site in November 1984; two detonations occurred at the 200 West Area Ash Pit Demolition Site in November 1984 and June 1986; and eleven detonations occurred at the HPADS from November 1984 to October 1991. Closure activities at the three sites were completed in 1995 in accordance with the closure plan,





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that included closure verification soil sampling and analyses. The results of these sampling and analyses activities show that the three units can be clean closed. Therefore, we request that the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) inform the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency RCRA Information System that these three TSD units are now "closed". The Part A, Form 3's, will be reissued with "CLOSED" stamped across them along with the date that Ecology responds to this letter.


