I. Approval of February 28, 2008 Liquid Processing and Capsule Storage Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved. The March 2008 PMM was cancelled.

II. Operational Status

LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (4/1/2008)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 14.9 ft or 4.1 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 17.2 ft or 5.2 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 15.0 ft or 4.2 Mgal

Received 184 tanker shipments, TX/TY groundwater and UP-1 groundwater during March

- Basin 43 received groundwater at ~50 gpm from TX/TY and UP-1 groundwater (4/1/08)
- Basin 44 received ~21,000 gallons* of leachate from the mixed waste burial trenches in 3 tankers
- Basin 44 received ~95,000 gallons* of ModuTank wastewater in 38 tankers
- Basin 44 received ~9,000 gallons* of purgewater in 18 tankers
- Basin 44 received ~6000,000 gallons* of K-Basin wastewater in 125 tankers

EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)

- Treated Basin 43 wastewater (~2.7 Mgal)
- Supported K-Basin dewatering with 24-hour tanker receipt until activity was completed ~3/19/2008

200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)

- Receiving wastewater at ~45 gpm (based on 4/1/2008 24-hour total flow)

300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)

- Receiving wastewater at 92 gpm average March flow (estimated)

340 COMPLEX

- Nothing to report

- * estimated volume is determined by multiplying the number of tankers received by a previously established tanker volume value that varies by tanker type

III. Project Specific Issues

A. Status of Dangerous Waste Permit Revisions

- 1. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) stated that RL/FH provided up-front permit conditions RCR and the closure addendum for review. Ms. Conaway is revising the statement of basis, and the groundwater permit conditions are in Ecology for resolution.

B. 310/340 Status

- 1. The status of 310/340 was briefly discussed. These facilities are planned for transfer to the River Corridor Project for disposition. The 340 facility is inactive, except for using power to monitor waste going into the basins.

C. ST4502 Permit Status

- 1. There was no change in status.

D. ST4500 Permit Status

- 1. There was no change in status.

IV. General Discussions

- 1. Ms. Conaway initiated a discussion regarding RL/FH's request to reuse verification tank wastewater by providing the following statement: "Ecology agreed that the application of WAC 173-303-017(2)(a) allows reuse of verification tank wastewater because the verification tank wastewater is not reclaimed prior to returning it to the original process or is a substitute for raw water. This determination supplements the determination made by EPA on August 19, 2005."

V. Status of Actions

- A. 1129 - Finalize LERF permit conditions for Ecology approval. RL/FH provided Ecology revised up-front permit conditions, RCR, and the closure addendum for review. The groundwater permit conditions and the statement of basis are in Ecology review.

- A. There were no new action items.

VIII. Next Project Managers Meeting
