Summary of Discussion**Unit Managers Meeting  
105-DR Large Sodium Fire Facility Closure Plan  
December 8, 1992**

**Sign Previous Meeting Minutes:** The November, 1992 Unit Managers Meeting minutes were reviewed and signed.

**Status of action items:** All action items are closed and there is no new information on the Reactor Decontamination & Decommissioning (D&D) Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

**Status of the NOD Response Table Preparation:** The Ecology Unit Manager (McKinney) received and reviewed the Notice of Deficiency (NOD) responses issued by RL/WHC on November 30, 1992. Ecology needs a month to look at the RL/WHC NOD responses in greater detail.

RL/WHC and Ecology agreed that submittal of the Health and Safety Plan (HASP) and the Sampling and Analysis Plan to Ecology for review may wait until an appropriate time prior to the commencement of field work. (The HASP must be prepared within a specific time frame of the start of work to be authorized by WHC Safety.)

A discussion ensued about the appropriate time to issue the first revision of the closure plan. WHC recommends revising the document now, and Ecology favored waiting until the end of this NOD cycle. Another NOD cycle will begin after the first revision and there will be a new numbering system once the new NOD cycle begins. Ecology will inform RL/WHC of when they think the revision should proceed based on Ecology's review of the NOD responses. Informal notification will be followed-up with a letter.

A short discussion of Ecology's initial impression of the NOD responses followed.

**Discuss any New Business:** There were no new items of business.

**Set Date for Next Meeting:** The next meeting will be on January 12, 1993, in Richland, Washington.
