COMPLETION OF MILESTONE M-016-94, "COMPLETE INTERIM REMEDIAL ACTIONS," FOR THE 100-B/C AREA

The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (RL) hereby provides notification of the completion of the subject milestone. Closure documentation activities for this milestone were completed on April 16, 2010.

RL appreciates the extensive efforts of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency staff in working with us to accomplish this milestone and performing cleanup activities in the River Corridor. Significant cleanup progress has been made in the 100-B/C Area. Twenty-two waste sites were remediated including reactor pipelines, underground process pipelines, a sodium dichromate pipeline, spillways, underground tanks, sumps, drywells, disposal sites, and chromium contaminated soils.
