SUMMARY

Discussed location of UST 6652-P. Brian said that the Generator Building is Building 6652-P and 3000 gallon tank behind building is 6652-P. Building 6652-P shows signs of a fire in my photos. The tank was geophysically located. He said I should talk to Ray Gerk (PNL) about tank removal at Control Center. The 1000 gallon tank on E side of 6652-C was removed based on a tank being excessed and vent pipe missing at 6652-C. A geophysical survey was performed at 6652-I building but could not confirm tank location where vent pipes were attached to building. Brian said that tank 6652-C contains unleaded gas and holds 6000 gallons.
