

- I. Approval of the September 27, 2001 200 LWPF Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status (Roger Szelmeczka, FH)
 - 242-A Evaporator**
Evaporator is in Shutdown mode
Next campaign planned for March/April 2002
 - Liquid Effluent Retention Facility (LERF)**
Waste Inventory (11/11/01)
 - Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 8.3 ft or 1.8 Mgal
 - Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 10.3 ft or 2.5 Mgal
 - Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 18.1 ft or 5.6 Mgal
 - Wastes received in LERF during October:
 - Basin 42 received 28,000 gallons of wastewater from 222-S by tanker
 - Basin 42 received 500 gallons of wastewater from HEHF
 - Basin 42 received 7100 gallons of leachate from the mixed waste burial trench
 - Basin 44 received 1600 gallons of wastewater from 105-F Basin by tanker
 - Basin 43 received UP-1 groundwater at approx. 50 gpm
 - 200 Area Effluent Treatment Facility (ETF)**
 - ETF is processing UP-1 groundwater at about 130 gpm
 - 200 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility (TEDF)**
October monthly flows:
 - Total discharge: 2.0 Mgal
 - Minimum daily flow: 3 gpm (10/20/01)
 - Maximum daily flow: 108 gpm (10/24/01)
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Delisting Petition Discussion
 1. Jamie Granger (FH) stated that the certification had been signed by VanLeuven and is currently at RL waiting for Keith Kline to sign.

2. The facility has received the toxicologist's report on how to address constituents without health-based risks. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) reported that he is working on inputs to a verification strategy for delisting.
- B. LERF Groundwater Discussion
 1. Fred Jamison (Ecology) stated that the small work group was making progress and should be done by December 24, 2001. The group is getting data that is much more useful.
 - C. PCB path forward
 1. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) reported that the facility is working with Dave Bartus on developing a model for risk-based disposal. The goal is to have the model in place before the next evaporator campaign. Everything looks good so far.
 - D. Status of permit revisions
 1. Roger Szelmeczka stated that the quarterly RCRA permit modifications are in works. The water permits will not have to be modified until the waste streams are known.
- IV. General Discussion
- A. Roger Szelmeczka transmitted the Results of Tritium Tracking and Groundwater Monitoring at the Hanford site 200 Area State-Approved Land Disposal Site letter to Kathy Conaway (Ecology). 200LWPF will transmit letters directly to Ecology to ensure timely delivery.
- V. Status of Action Items
- A. LWPF-00-004 (561) -- action was closed. The certification was submitted to RL for signature.
 - B. LWFP-00-018 (709) -- action remains open. Discussions continued through November.
 - C. LWFP-01-024 (757) -- action remains open. A draft schedule was prepared on 11/29. Discussions continue on schedule.
