**PHASE 1: PREPARE 30/40/50 MVA GE POWER TRANSFORMER, ID NO. X-1, B5864C,  
 AT THE HANFORD RESERVATION 400 AREA FOR SHIPMENT**

**Background:** The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has requested the transfer to BPA of the de-energized 30/40/50 MVA GE power Transformer, ID No. X-1, B5864C (Transformer B5864C) from the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office's (DOE Richland) de-energized 451A substation located in the 400 Area on the Hanford Reservation. This Reimbursable Agreement (Agreement) provides for DOE Richland to prepare the transformer for shipment to BPA. The contractual transfer of equipment is being handled under Transfer Order No. 242692.



**BPA and DOE Richland hereby agree:** Under Phase 1 of this project, DOE Richland will perform the following activities at BPA's expense:

- Coordinate and provide for the disconnection, draining, and preparation for removal of Transformer B5864C from the 451A substation, including:
  - draining the 115 kV transformer (first and final drains totaling 6,700 gallons); and
  - removing the 115 kV transformer bushings, 115 kV surge arrestors, and cooling fins (radiators).
- Coordinate with BPA Riggers the transfer of Transformer B5864C onto BPA's flat bed trailer.
- Coordinate and manage any supplemental personnel or resources, including work management support for package development, Integrated Safety Management System (ISMS) walkdowns, operation support for switching order preparation, engineering support, boom truck support, and Radiological Survey (Rad Con Survey) as necessary to support turn-over of the excess property.

The estimated completion date for this work is December 31, 2009.
