The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Office of River Protection would like to bring you up to date on the planned leak assessment of Tank 241-C-105, by DOE, which was planned for Fiscal Year (FY) 2008. The resources which were scheduled to perform the C-105 tank leak assessment were utilized in addressing the changing liquid levels (water mound and interstitial liquid levels) in the SX-104 tank. The leak assessment of Tank 241-C-105 is planned to occur during the first quarter of FY 2009.

The leak assessments for 241-C-111 and 241-C-110 were completed prior to September 30, 2008. The Tank Farm Project plans to update the tank integrity documentation and the waste information data system after the Tank 241-C-105 leak assessment is complete.
