The Department of Ecology (Ecology) reviewed the Certified Supplemental Information provided by the United States Department of Energy – Richland Operations Office and CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company (the Permittees) for the 241-CX Tank System, Closure Unit Group 15 and Hexone Storage and Treatment Facility, Closure Unit Group 19, Addendum G, "Personnel Training" (Reference).

Ecology accepts the Supplemental Information in support of the *Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Permit for the Treatment, Storage, and Disposal of Dangerous Waste* (Site-wide Permit), Revision 9, renewal application.

Ecology worked with the United States Department of Energy and its contractors on the content of Addendum G, "Personnel Training." Ecology confirms that all agreed to changes are incorporated and have been addressed sufficiently. We will incorporate the content of the Supplemental Information in the draft Site-wide Permit, Revision 9.

In accordance with Washington Administrative Code 173-303-806(7), the Permittees will comply with the *Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit, Dangerous Waste Portion for the Treatment, Storage, and Disposal of Dangerous Waste*, Revision 8C until the effective date of the Site-wide Permit, Revision 9.
