Summary of Discussion

WHC (T. A. Wilczek) reported that the best and final offer period for receiving bids is over and there was only one response, which increases the steps which must be taken to ensure that the bid is competitive. Preliminary indications are that the bid will be acceptable. Nothing is foreseen which should hold up the procurement process, and the bid appears competitive based on past information received.

DOE (S. L. Trine) reported that the Waste Designation Letter has been stuck in the Line Organization since May 16, 1991. Once it has gotten through there, it could be out as early as the end of the week (May 24, 1991). The letter basically asks Ecology to confirm that WT-02 is the appropriate waste code.

Ecology (J. Witczak) stated that in order to speed things up, if a sampling procedure has been discussed between the Ecology and WHC\DOE and concurrence is expected, a letter requesting Ecology concurrence can be written containing language which states that Ecology will have 30 days to respond, and if there is no response then the plan can be considered acceptable. If Ecology has not had time to review a sampling plan or is not given enough response time, Ecology will send a reply of no.

WHC (T. A. Wilczek) reported that sampling is scheduled for the June-July 1991 time frame. It is hoped by WHC that there will be no "log jams" of the sampling resources will take place to interrupt sampling. WHC (F. A. Ruck III) stated that one of big concerns with 2727-S is sampling concrete for organics. Mr. Ruck stated that, since the 300 Area Solvent Evaporater is the leading edge for organic sampling in concrete, 2727-S will dovetail in with 300 ASE decisions for concrete sampling.

WHC (F. A. Ruck III) stated that the K-25 laboratory in Oak Ridge will be the laboratory for rad and non-rad samples.
