Description of current waste site condition:

The site is a small pile of scrap steel angle iron, sheet metal, and piping, discovered during an annual RCRA General Inspection July 15 -16, 1996. The surrounding area is covered with tumbleweeds, cheatgrass, and sagebrush. However, the soil on top of the metal is bare, due to the inability of vegetation to grow on the very shallow soils covering the metal.

Basis for reclassification:

The site is a pile of discarded steel beams and pipes. There is no evidence of hazardous or dangerous waste.
