

Feasibility Study Work Plan(s) (RI/FS) violate the
parameters established in the Implementation Plan?
When so little is known about the 200 Area soil group-
ings, an inductive methodology would be more "stream-
lined" and "efficient" than a deductive one.

For example, if one were blindfolded and were to hear a
quacking, one would conclude they were confronting a
duck. Further investigation, i.e., removal of the
blindfold, might reveal a hunter using a duck-call.
One's original deduction would, therefore, be only
unsubstantiated musings.
