SUBJECT: Stop Document Preparation for 100-KR-2 and 100-FR-2

Dear Ms McClain:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recommends that your current efforts related to Proposed Plans and Focused Feasibility Studies for the 100-KR-2 and 100-FR-2 operable units be terminated. This is in anticipation of reaching a Tri-Party agreement in the near future to address the remaining waste sites in the 100 Area on a 100 Area wide rather than an operable unit basis. The EPA considers the existing documentation adequate to satisfy existing milestone requirements for the 100-KR-2 and 100-FR-2 operable units.

When the framework for 100 Area wide decisions is determined, appropriate documentation will be established at that time. The EPA does not anticipate that additional revisions of the above mentioned operable unit specific documents will be cost effective towards use in 100-Area-wide waste-site-type Record of Decisions.

The EPA currently has, for our review and comment, the following documents: 100-BC-2 Proposed Plan and Focused Feasibility Study, and 100-FR-1 Proposed Plan and Focused Feasibility Study. The EPA does not plan to send additional comments, if any, on those documents until the 100 Area ROD strategy is determined. At that time, any comments that would be sent would be in conjunction with documentation deemed appropriate at that time.

The EPA requests the cost savings from these decisions be applied to actual cleanup. Please contact me at (509) 376-9529 with any questions.


