As we have recently discussed and as described in recent correspondence between DOE-RL and the Environmental Restoration and Waste Management component of the Nez Perce Tribe (P. Sobotta to/from S. Wisness), the Surface Environmental Surveillance Project/Public Safety and Resource Protection Program acknowledge the commitment to include the sampling effort on the Horseshoe Landfill beginning in FY03. The FY 2003 Project Documentation Package for the Surface Environmental Surveillance Project is currently under preparation and will include an upper level description of this effort. It is our understanding that this effort is to include biological sampling as determined appropriate through our routine planning process as well as coordination with the Tribes during the detailed planning activity. This detailed planning and the identification of specific types and numbers of samples to be collected is currently scheduled during October/November 2002. We are looking forward to working with RL and the Tribes in defining the specifics of this sampling effort.
