DELEGATION OF REMEDIAL PROJECT MANAGER (RPM) FOR 200-UPR-E-83 WASTE SITE/200-UR-1 OPERABLE UNIT REMEDIAL ACTIONS CONDUCTED UNDER THE COMPREHENSIVE ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE, COMPENSATION AND LIABILITY ACT (CERCLA) AT THE HANFORD SITE

The purpose of this letter is to notify the State of Washington Department of Ecology and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has delegated Margo Voogd as the RPM for the 200-UPR-E-83 Waste Site/200-UR Operable Unit remedial actions conducted under CERCLA on the Central Plateau of the Hanford Site.
