
Description of current waste site condition:

In 1981, contaminated pigeon feces were found in the vicinity of the 204-S Waste Unloading Facility and 221-U. The source of the contamination was determined to be the water accumulating in the 204-S tank basin.

Basis for reclassification:

In 1981, the north 204-S tank basin was decontaminated to background radiation levels, and the affected area around 221-U was chained off and posted as a radiation area. A clean up plan was implied in the occurrence report, but there is no documentation of the actual decontamination of areas effected by the pigeon feces.

The release is not physically marked or posted. The source of the contamination has been eliminated. The 203-S, 204-S and 205-S facilities were demolished in 1983. The area around the facilities, including the Unloading Facility, have been surface stabilized. It is recommended this site be reclassified to No Action.
