This letter addresses the Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Part A Permit Application, Form 3 for the Single-Shell Tank (SST) System.

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received and reviewed the U. S. Department of Energy's (USDOE) Dangerous Waste Part A Permit Application, Form 3. The scope of the changes include:

Replacing Fluor Daniel Hanford, Inc. (FDH) with Lockheed Martin Hanford Corporation (LMHC) as the co-operator of this unit.

Adding one diversion box (AX-155) to Section III C.

The Part A, Form 3, Revision 5, for the SST System was found to be acceptable as submitted.
