## 1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

The September 1, 1994 Unit Manager Meeting minutes were approved.

## Schedule

Ms. A. Prignano (WHC) reported that RL/WHC and Ecology have resolved all but four notice of deficiency (NOD) comments. Ms. Prignano stated that she would provide a copy of the four outstanding NODs to RL and Ecology. Ms. Prignano noted that the remaining NODs required additional information, and that they should be resolved when Revision 2 of the closure plan is submitted to Ecology.

## Permit Modification

Ms. Prignano stated that a videoconference was held September 22, 1994, with RL/WHC, Ecology and EPA to discuss incorporating the 216-B-3 Expansion Ponds' closure plan into the Hanford Facility Permit through the permit modification process. Ecology was to send a letter to RL documenting an agreement that the Hanford Facility Permit modification process would correspond with the Expansion Ponds' closure activities schedule. Ms. J. Wallace (Ecology) stated that she would discuss the letter with Mr. M. Jaraysi (Ecology) and Mr. R. Harper (Ecology).

## Public Involvement

Ms. Prignano stated that the public involvement issue was also discussed during the September 22, 1994 meeting with RL/WHC, Ecology and EPA. Ms. Wallace indicated that Mr. Harper has initiated the public involvement aspect regarding incorporation of the Expansion Ponds' closure plan into the Hanford Facility Permit.

**3. Status Action Items**

Action item 02-23-94:2a, WHC (F. A. Ruck) will set up a groundwater meeting with Ecology to discuss Chapter 5.

Ms. Prignano stated that several meetings have been held. This action item was closed.

Action item 02-23-94:2b, WHC (F. A. Ruck) will set up a groundwater meeting with the appropriate people from the groundwater section of WHC, BHI, and Ecology to discuss corrective action of the aquifer in conjunction with the Main Pond.

RL/WHC, BHI and Ecology agreed that this action item should be transferred to the 216-B-3 Main Pond Unit Managers Meeting.

Action item 04-13-94:1a, WHC (F. A. Ruck) will discuss the Hanford Facility Permit modification process with Ecology.

Mr. Ruck stated that several meetings have been held. It was agreed to close this action item, and a status will be provided at the Unit Manager Meetings.

Action item 04-13-94:1b, RL (R. Krekel) will initiate development of a public involvement strategy to provide information to the public regarding the closure activity in an effort to address any concerns or questions.

Mr. Krekel initiated the public involvement action, and it was agreed to close this action item.

Ms. Wallace inquired about receipt of the revision of the closure plan. Ms. Prignano responded that the closure plan and the NOD response table will be transmitted to Ecology on October 31, 1994.

Mr. R. Tranbarger (IT) inquired about the ultimate responsibility for the M-17-10 Milestone (cease discharge to the 216-B-3 Expansion Ponds), noting that Bechtel is funding the project. Mr. Ruck responded that it is WHC's responsibility, since WHC is responsible for the Part A permit application.
