





III. Project Specific Issues

A. Conversion of LLW Line Status

1. The conversion should be completed by the end of April.

B. Permit Status

1. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) met with Ecology and worked out an agreement to revise the glovebox terminology. The gloveboxes will be categorized as 100-series, 200-series, 300-series and 400-series. A table will be provided that identifies process capabilities for each type. Updates will be provided to Ecology for incorporation into the permit.
2. The onsite/offsite issue is on hold.

IV. General Discussions

- A. Ms. Hyatt provided a status update on the implementation of the accelerated process line (APL) units being provided by WIPP to support TRU processing. A meeting was held with the Carlsbad staff to determine their support needs. The APLs will arrive in advance of the pads being ready so that training and familiarization can begin. The units may be temporarily parked behind the WRAP facility.
