



EXTENSION AT THE PROJECT MANAGER LEVEL FOR THE HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) DISPUTE REGARDING U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY, OFFICE OF RIVER PROTECTION DENIAL OF WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY CHANGE CONTROL FORM M-45-19-02, DESIGN AND PERMIT NEW, COMPLIANT TANKS

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) initiated the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order or Tri-Party Agreement (TPA) dispute resolution process with the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection (ORP) on July 22, 2019 (19-NWP-122) at the project manager level, in accordance with TPA Article VIII, Paragraph 30, Resolution of Disputes. The Parties hereby agree to extend the period of dispute resolution for change control form M-45-19-02 at the project manager level until January 16, 2020. The Parties jointly determined that this extension is desirable to provide them additional time to reach resolution regarding this dispute.
