TRANSMITTAL OF THE BURIAL GROUND SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS RESULTS FOR  
JANUARY - MARCH 2006

Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Milestone M-91-40, requirement 2, paragraph 3, requires quarterly reports of results from retrieval burial grounds sampling and analysis plan (SAP) sampling activities. No sampling and analysis activities were conducted under the M-91-40 SAPs for the 218-W-4C, 218-E-12B, or 218-W-3A Burial Grounds during the January-March quarter so no analysis results for those burial grounds are provided. Based on the sampling design in the M-91-40 SAPs, additional sampling is planned following retrieval of the suspect transuranic wastes from the individual burial grounds.
