The TWRS Draft EIS assesses the environmental impacts associated with managing and disposing of more than 56 million gallons of radioactive, hazardous, and mixed waste in 177 underground tanks, and approximately 60 miscellaneous underground storage tanks, and managing and disposing of approximately 1,930 cesium and strontium capsules at the Hanford Site. The EIS is being co-prepared by DOE and the Washington State Department of Ecology.

DOE will conduct a public hearing on the Draft EIS. At the public hearing, DOE and Ecology representatives will provide background information on the technical analysis in the Draft EIS, be available to respond to questions regarding the Draft EIS, and receive public comments on the Draft EIS.
