Description of current waste site condition:

The dangerous waste was kept in a connex box commercially manufactured for storing wastes. The box has a spill containment system in that the waste was stored on a grate at the level of the door threshold, and any spills would be contained under the grate so they could not spill out the door. All wastes previously stored have been removed. The box is still in place, but is now used to store hazardous material intended for future use, such as roofing material, propylene glycol (trade name Dow Frost), and oils.
