It would be good to have a briefing (in writing OR in person) on these readings and what they might mean -- is the ERDF liner leaking? is there another source that makes sense? how does this stuff move through the soil and what are its effects?

Another issue that bears watching is the Long Term Stewardship Report. It's mostly general information, not specific enough for Trustee Council comment. But there is one statement that caught my eye and sent up red flags: In the Washington, Hanford section 2.2 Assumptions and Uncertainties, one the bullets states "Contaminated groundwater will remain unremediated in the All Other Areas, Central Plateau, and 100 Area."
