
Enclosed is a "Certification of Compliance with the Department of the Army Permit." The certification of compliance is required by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Permit Number 92-2-00961, dated December 29, 1993, for construction of the Hanford 300 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility (TEDF) Outfall. 34106

The USACE Permit was obtained in accordance with Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 United States Code (U.S.C.) 403) and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344).

Construction of the Hanford 300 Area TEDF Outfall was authorized under Hanford Construction Project L-045H, and completed on March 2, 1994. Installation of the outfall was completed in accordance with the USACE Permit under the supervision of ICF Kaiser Hanford Company. The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office, is complying with the State of Washington Department of Ecology Water Quality Certification and all other local, state, and federal requirements associated with construction of the outfall.
