
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

An area of debris was identified during a 1997 RCRA Permit General Inspection tour. The site consists of a pile of dirt approximately 10 feet in diameter containing wire, fencing material, metal scrap, cable and grounding rods. The site is not marked or radiologically posted.

**Basis for reclassification:**

No evidence exists to indicate hazardous, dangerous, or radioactive waste was disposed at this site. A radiological survey, done in December 2004, found no contamination readings above background levels.
